



2020-2021 LEARNING OPTIONS

OPTION A

Traditional On-Campus Instruction

- Face-to-Face Instruction
- Traditional Teaching Methods
 - Instruction
 - Grading
 - Discipline
 - Attendance
- Social Distancing Guidelines
 - Hand Washing Emphasized
 - Increased Disinfecting Practices
 - Masks encouraged (when appropriate)
 - Distancing Guidelines Enforced
- Instruction guided by the Alabama Content Standards

OPTION B

Remote Learning

- Online Curriculum/PK-12 Guided by the Alabama Content Standards
- Guided by a Walker County Certified Teacher
- WCS will remain responsible for students.
- Attendance will be reported for each day the WCS are in session.
- Pacing guides used to determine progress.
- WCS extra-curricular activities will be offered to eligible students.
- Remote learning students may switch to the Traditional On-Campus Learning (at designated times.).
- On-Campus attendance may be required for ALSDE assessments or other school functions.

BLENDED LEARNING will take place when Traditional On-Campus learning poses a risk to the health and safety of faculty and students (schoolwide or even in small groups). This option is only available to Traditional On-Campus students. Instruction would be continued by a teacher from the Walker County School System via an online platform. Students would return to On-Campus instructions upon completion of the Health Department guidelines. Attendance will be taken and students will be expected to complete assignments. "Sick Days" will be coded as excused absences with proper documentation. If individual student sickness occurs, the student will be required to complete assignments upon recovery.

Parents will have an opportunity to choose enrollment "Option A" or "Option B" in late July or early August after instructional plans are finalized.
